The petition for writ of supersedeas, filed December 22, 2005; the opposition thereto, filed January 11, 2006; and the reply, filed January 19, 2006, have been read and considered.

The parties shall proceed by way of appendixes in lieu of a clerk's transcript (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 5.1) according to the following schedule:

1. A joint appendix or the appellant's appendix, a reporter's transcript (if there is to be one) and the appellant's opening brief on appeal shall be filed and personally served within 45 days after the date of this order. (Rule 5.1(e).)

2. The respondent's brief (and respondent's appendix if there is no joint appendix) shall be filed and personally served within 30 days after the appellant's opening brief has been filed and served. (Rule 5.1(e).)

3. The appellant's reply brief (and appellant's reply appendix if there is no joint appendix) shall be filed and personally served within 15 days after the respondent's brief is filed and served.

Oral argument shall be held on July 26, 2006.
